GENERAL DO'S AND DON'TS

Before discussing specific strategies to help you in the IELTS speaking test, let's look at some general do's and don'ts. These will give you a general idea of what is required to get a successful band in the test. This book will discuss and explain these tips in more detail.

Do ...

- √ listen to the questions carefully
- √ give relevant answers
- ✓ ask for clarification if you don't understand the question
- √ express your opinions and give examples to support your ideas
- ✓ use conversation fillers to give yourself time to think
- √ relax and enjoy yourself
- √ try to use interesting adjectives
- √ paraphrase if you don't know a word
- √ speak clearly

Don't ...

- give very short answers
- repeat yourself all the time and overuse simple words
- memorize long answers
- get stressed if you don't understand the question
- make long frequent pauses
- speak too quietly
- spell your name for the examiner
- use your native language
- use words or idioms that you are not sure about
- write on the task card in Part 2 of the test
- ask the examiner if what you say is correct
